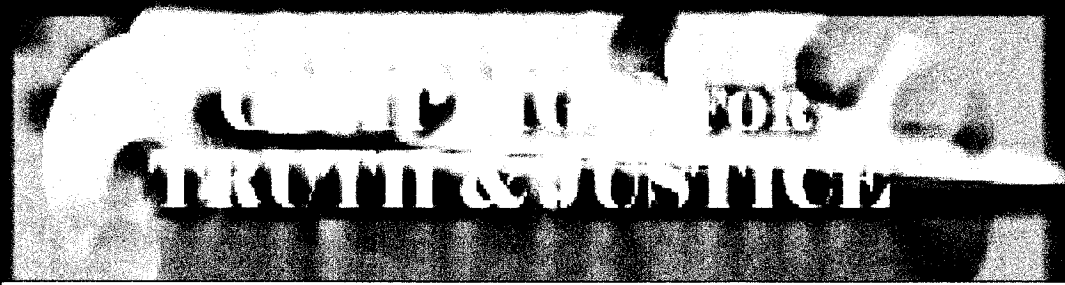
- This Court formally transferred your appeal to the High Court on 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2003.

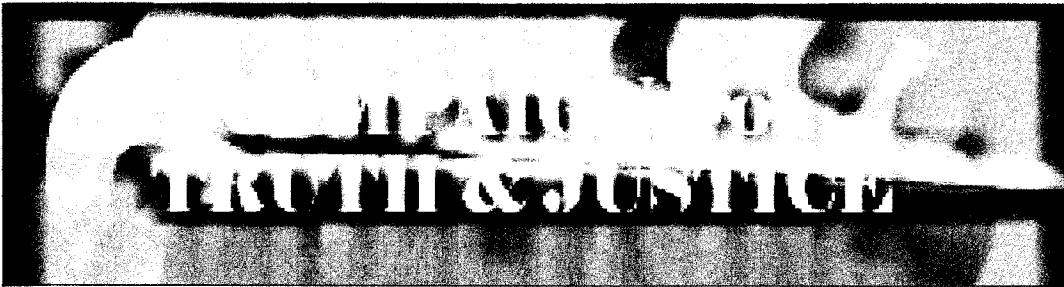

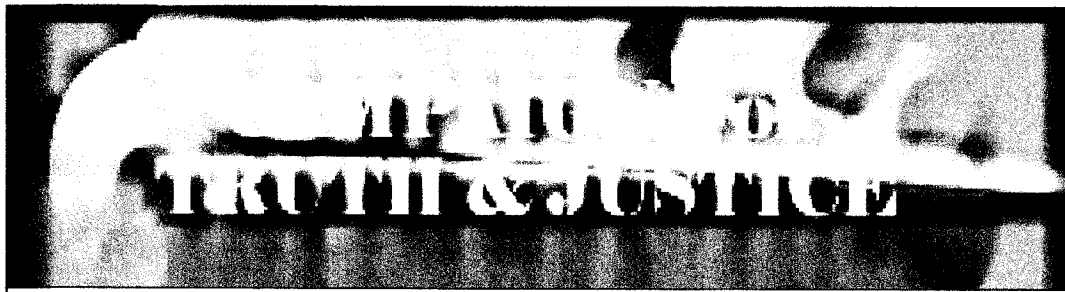

**REF: All of the Above names' Overdue and Outstanding Appeal since 6<sup>th</sup> January 2003, Against Highbury Corner Magistrates' for Unlawful Imprisonment and non compliance with Process and Procedure enacted to safeguard the Defendants right to Article 6 under the 1998 Human Rights Act.**

This is to confirm that all of the above named members of this campaign have still to date not had their Appeal for Unlawful Imprisonment against Highbury Corner Justices heard.

**Brief Outline:**

I and the above named Appellants were found to be in contempt of court, pursuant to Section 12 of the contempt of court Act 1981 on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2003. I received a sentence of 7 days imprisonment and the other above named Appellants received 5 days imprisonments. We appealed against both conviction and sentence.

To-date none of the above have had an appeal. We feel for these reasons that our appeal have been deliberately tampered with. Additionally the excessive long delay is unjustifiable and relates entirely to the huge level of corruption which exists within the entire judicial system.

We want our Appeal right exercised and require from you within 14 days the position of its where about within the courts. Additionally we hold you in the administration responsible for all failures to properly inform and communicate progress to us. Also there is no one other than you responsible for misinforming and deliberately altering Appellant information including date of birth, addresses, court records, etc, which has been taking place at will.

**Re: Your complaint**

I write further to my earlier letters dated 18<sup>th</sup> June 2004 and 8<sup>th</sup> July 2004, in response to your most recent letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> July 2004.

I note the points made in your letter of 5<sup>th</sup> July but can inform you that the original indication that no appeal has been received on your behalf, remains the case. I understand from your letter of 21<sup>st</sup> June 2004, that on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2003 you were found to be in contempt of court at Highbury Corner Magistrates Court and I can confirm that it is possible to challenge the decision to find you in contempt by way of Judicial Review.

Judicial Review is an avenue of appeal that is open to you but in order for any proceedings to go ahead, you will be required to formally file an application for Judicial Review here at the Administrative Court Office. It follows from your letter that as no application for Judicial Review has ever been made to the Administrative Court Office, we would have no reason to contain the details of any of the people that you mention (in your letter of 15<sup>th</sup> June 2004) in our system.

Until an application for Judicial Review is formally filed with the Administrative Court Office, we will not be in a position to assist you in this matter any further. In order to facilitate an application for Judicial Review, please find enclosed an application pack that contains all notes for guidance and requisite forms. However, I do advise that you seek legal advice before instigating any, potentially costly, legal proceedings.

Please do not hesitate to contact me at the above address if you require any further information or assistance in this matter.



**REF: AHMED BALOGUN, CAUL GRANT, & OTHERS V HIGHBURYCORNER JUSTICES'**

Following the corruption emanating from within the Judiciary, Myself and Six other members of this campaign were wrongly alleged in contempt of court by District Judge Pigott on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2003.

An appeal against conviction dated 13<sup>th</sup> January 2003 was initially lodged, but because the court was bombarded by a number of deliberately misleading skeleton arguments on behalf of the Magistrates', on behalf of the Crown, and on behalf of the Attorney General's Chamber, stating wrongly that the Crown Court had no jurisdiction to hear an appeal in relation to a finding of Contempt of Court, the matter was never heard.

As it has now turned out, such advice given by those acting for and on behalf of the Crown or state is incorrect and has led to a grave injustice occurring. The appeal against conviction pursuant to Article 6 of the European Convention of Human Rights, as enshrined under the Human Rights Act 1998 must now be heard and ruled upon.

The right herein sought is an appeal 'as of right', namely, access to an Appellant Court following a Conviction at the Court below, and right to a fair hearing.

A renewed notice of Appeal against Conviction was lodged 25<sup>th</sup> August 2005 at the Inner London Crown Court. To-date there has been no communication or appeal hearing and we therefore once again suspect that this might once again be due to further ongoing corruption prevalent in the Judiciary.
