Dear Mr Blair,

The time is rapidly approaching when I would have served half of the unlawful prison sentence I'm currently serving. It is a great shame that all the opportunity which has been on the table to find an acceptable resolution have now been lost.

Since contacting you and bringing to your attention that I have been convicted and imprisoned without the right of appeal, the responsibility fell on you to look into the facts, it is total hypocrisy to go around the world bombing and killing innocent women and children in the name of Human Rights and Justice whilst violating those principles at home. Peace demands Justice and as Dr Martin Luther King once said, "If there is no Justice then there is no god" are you ready to tell the world that there is no god?

The issues involved in this case will never go away unless they are resolved, they cannot be avoided for ever, not whilst I'm alive and I do not believe you are ready to order my assassination.

I will go to my grave believing in God and in Justice and I pledge my life to fight for both, Justice for one is Justice for all, so there is honour in my fight, but only cowardice in those who are suppressing the Truth.
