
Delivered the following unanimous decision on 15 June 2001:

The Court has examined the application lodged on 23 February 2001 and finds that the final domestic decision within the meaning of Article 35 § 1 of the Convention was the refusal of leave to appeal given by the Court of Appeal on 22 January 1999 and thus more than six months before the date on which the application was submitted to the Court. It follows that the application has been submitted too late and must be rejected, in accordance with Article 35 § 4.

Accordingly, the Court

Declares the application inadmissible.
