Complaint about the Judiciary

Thank you for your letter of 17 August 2007.

As you raised concerns about a member of the Judiciary this office is the correct one to respond to your complaint.

The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice will not consider complaints which allege misconduct, but really arise because the complainant is dissatisfied with a particular judicial decision. As I have already advised, in those cases, the person aggrieved should seek to appeal to a higher court.
