On 10/05/2005 Campaign for Truth & Justice posted the following enclosed petition on the Downing Street Website in lieu of your administration's, (and established institutions like **the Law Society, Criminal Cases Review Commission, Lord Chancellor's Department, the Home Office, Local MPs, and the Ministry of Justice's**) ongoing failures to investigate and give due redress to serious matters of False and Unlawful Imprisonment issues, (most particularly regarding Mr. Caul Silford Grant and Others) brought to your attention.

We note that because of both your Government and Departmental Minister's interest in suppressing these facts from the general public as a consequence of the resounding public administration failures, your government have not allowed the inclusion of the campaign's petition on to the Downing Street Petition Board for perusal and signing by the general public.

Now the petition fully complied with stated terms and conditions as expressed on the Downing Street website for all Petition postings. A copy of it is enclosed for all to see and judge for themselves. As qualifying citizen, it is paramount you remember that Government is not your exclusive ownership and thus require the posting of the petition, which is of Right and not a privilege.

Be warned! you have very little time left in office. **False and Unlawful Imprisonment of any citizen as a consequence of Judicial Corruption is very grave and serious indeed.** If you do not resolve this matter involving most especially that of Mr. Caul Silford Grant and Others brought to you and your, Government Minister's and Departmental attention, (**the Home Office, Lord Chancellor's Department etc.,**) the new Ministry of Justice created on the hop without adequate consultation with the public will be ineffective and inoperable!!!

As already pointed out to you once before, **the unruly lawlessness of your administration from an Home Office established on record 'not fit for purpose', to a Corrupt Lord Chancellor's Department, which since 1998 has failed to give re-dress to established instances of Unlawful Imprisonments as a consequence of Judicial Corruption and Improprieties, is utter contempt for the Rule of Law.** Know now that you will not be able to suppress these facts forever.
